



CERTIFICATE OF CONFIRMATION OF NON-COLLUSION

Notes for the tenderer/bidder

- 3. If a specific task is not identified separately in the above list, the Contractor shall assume that it is included as part of another related listed item or items, and shall base his lump sum amounts on this assumption.
- 4. Unistrut sub-frame provisional sum
 - a. The exact extent of work required for the supply and installation of the unistrut sub-frame is not suitably detailed to provide a lump sum bid price.
 - b. This sum is intended to be used to cover the cost of this work including all labour, materials, equipment, overhead and profit.
 - c. This sum will be adjusted to reflect the actual cost of the work and a variation order will be issued to record the changes to the contract price.
- 5. Bullet catch and overhead safety baffles provisional sum
 - a. The exact extent of work required for the supply, installation, commissioning and training of the bullet catch and overhead safety baffles is not suitably detailed to provide a lump sum bid price.
 - b. The provisional sum shown is based on a quotation from Savage Range Systems and includes shipping, duty, wharfage, a skilled technician from the manufacturer for 18 days, two local labours and one foreman for 18 x 8 hour days, attendance, equipment, overhead and profit.
 - c. This sum will be adjusted to reflect the actual cost of the work and a variation order will be issued to record the changes to the contract price.
- 6. Time to install the sub-frame, the bullet catch, safety baffles, commissioning and training is estimated to be 18 days.
